

A note from Christina.....

Dear UBC Members,

Leander and I wish you a very happy and healthy New Year all the way from Germany! I am glad still to receive your newsletter and see familiar names and faces:)

Much has happened here in the last year. In May, I bought a little, red brick row house in the city of Solingen, and my mother (who is 84 now) moved in with us. Her room is on the ground floor, just like the kitchen and the big bathroom. She had trouble getting up to the stairs to our rented apartment, so we thought it wise to combine households where she could get around easily and we can still cook together and go on outings. Almost every weekend we go on trips to castles, animal parks, dripstone caves, zoos, planetariums, museums, swimming pools, or indoor playgrounds.

I sold David's house on Jefferson Street last year, after I had no rental income for three years (but had to make the mortgage payments) and had to evict the tenant, who was in it all the time and broke many windows and ceiling. She didn't have to pay rent due to the moratorium during the pandemic and then simply vanished without being held responsible for anything.

In Germany, I still work as team assistant at <u>Global rail Academy in Leverkussen</u>, where we give training courses (tamping, hydraulics, brakes, etc.) to railroad track construction workers. I've now sat in tamping simulators many times (and so has Leander) and faked track tamping, and we've also been on real tamping machines at fairs and open-house days. It is a fun work to prepare our courses, greet our participants and visitors and arrange all the worldwide travels of our company. We operate in the U.S. and in Vienna, Austria as well, and our company language is English.

Christmas we celebrated in my new house, together with grandma and my sister Rosi, her husband, and her tow teenage kids. This month, Leander will be six years old already!! His biggest wish was a hamster, and it came true yesterday, after we spent several weeks of getting the cage and the supplies together. His hamster "Centex" is now living with us two on the attic, where my son has his big playroom and can learn how to take care of an animal properly. I hope you are doing fine and are all healthy. I miss my UBC family. We haven't found a new church in Solingen yet. There is still a lot to do in my house (which is from the 80s), and which I painted by myself. Thus, I keep busy when I'm not working, and Leandy always keeps me busy, anyway;)
