How to live in anxious times. There are many things that cause modern day Christians to be anxious. There are political issues, financial distress, worries about the state of the Church in our day, health issues, personal relationships, etc. And there are several phrases that are offerings for people trying to cope with any or all of these things.

Many of them are put together in a song that goes like this:

Many things about tomorrow I don't seem to understand.
But I know who holds tomorrow And I know who holds my hand.

Other words that come to my mind are from Reinhold Niebuhr's versions of the Serenity Prayer which goes like this: *God, give me grace to accept with serenity the things that cannot be changed, Courage to change the things which should be changed, and the Wisdom to distinguish the one from the other.*

The prayer bids us have the courage to know who holds the future and have the courage to change those things we think need to be changed. We can do what one person can do. And when we know there are things we cannot change at this moment we take faith in the God who holds the future and **holds us** in that future. The key part is to have the wisdom to distinguish the one from the other.

The words that anchor me come from the hymn It Is Well with My Soul.

When peace like a river, attendeth my way,

When sorrows like sea billows roll

Whatever my lot, thou hast taught me to say

It is well, it is well, with my soul.

God, give me grace to accept with serenity the things that cannot be changed, Courage to change the things which should be changed, and the Wisdom to distinguish the one from the other.

Reflect upon these things and find rest for your anxious soul.




